ORGANIZATION (Speech follows a clear, logical outline with a beginning, middle and end)

- Introduction points the way
- Main points of body were clearly designated
- Speaker does not digress
- Conclusion is satisfactory and definite
- Transitional devices are used effectively

Your introduction was clever. It grabbed our attention, but made a clear point.

Good Job - it was clear what side of the arguement you where on!

CONTENT (Speech is persuasive and has a clear purpose)

- Speech shows sufficient investigation
- Speech is written in an interesting and relevant manner
- Speaker makes effective use of cited material
- Word choice and usage was appropriate for the topic.
- Topic is interesting, compelling and appropriate for the audience

Good use of quotes. The ones you picked really backed up your point of view.

Your topic was well researched, but sometimes seemed bogged down in too much detail. Make sure what you are presenting isn't over your audiences head. You want to give them facts they can digest.

DELIVERY (used appropriate techniques to enhance the effectiveness of the speech)

- Speaker is sincere and convincing
- Speaker makes effective use of eye contact and facial expression
- Speaker makes effective use of gestures and bodily action
- Speaker's variety in pitch, rate, volume and tone contributes to the persuasiveness of the speech
- Articulation is clear; pronunciation is correct
- Speaker was poised and confident

Good eye contact - shows us you know what you are talking about!

Good Subtle movements! Highlighted your points without being distracting!

When you are going over all the stats, make sure you vary your tone - avoid being monotone - help keep your audience engaged!

If you mess up words, don't panic! Keep going and don't draw attention to your fumble.

TOTAL EFFECTIVENESS (The speech effectively fulfilled its intended purpose)

- Speech flowed smoothly
- Speaker presented adequate logic and support for their argument

Well outlined speech! You followed a clear path to your conclusion, and back up your thinking. Good job!

I don't know if I agree with your conclusion, but you presented a good argument. Really gave me something to think about!

You gave a thought-provoking speech, but you may want to do a little editing. Make sure you are giving enough to support, without making it a lecture.
